## **Memory Verse**

## Connect

Think of a time in your life when you've been tempted to seek revenge? What were your feelings and thoughts at the time?

## Commit

Read Esther 2:19-3:15

- Subplots abound. Secrecy, concubines, obedience, plots to assassinate. Which ones most concern Xerxes? Mordecai? Esther?
- 2. What is the conflict between Haman & Mordecai that causes Haman's intense reaction to Mordecai (v.2-6)?

- What might the author have been trying to communicate in his detailed description of the edict? Describe the atmosphere of the kingdom after the edict had been proclaimed.
- 4. Read Ephesians 4:25-27. How do you usually deal with anger? What do you learn about anger from this story and Paul's exhortation in Ephesians 4?
- 5. Describe the cycle of pain that Pastor Rick referred to his in message. Why doesn't seeking revenge work?
- 6. Read Ephesians 4:32. How might you guard against anger and seeking revenge in your relationships? Is there a person in your life that God may be asking you to forgive? If so, how can we pray for you?
