3. Read Proverbs 21:1. How does this chapter illustrate this proverb? Do you believe that God guides the hearts of today's political leaders and kings? What hope does this bring you?

4. Describe how Haman felt during the different events of the day. How do Jesus' words in Luke 14:11, describe Haman's life at this moment?

5. What does Mordecai's meekness and loyalty bring him? What spiritual lessons do you see at work here (See Matthew 23:12)?

6. The truth is that Haman isn't going to win against God. In what ways do you try to be in control of your circumstances? What life lessons to you learn from this story?
