Commit to Growth

Read Matthew 25:31-46, Luke 4:16-21

1. Discuss the six acts of service that Jesus refers to in Matthew 25:35-36. What do you think this passage says about God’s priorities for His people?

2. Do you hear any descriptions in Jesus’ words in Matthew 25:35-36 that you would use to describe ways God has helped you in different seasons of your life? Either literally or spiritually!

3. Jesus taught that what you do or do not do to “the least” is what you are doing to Jesus. How might this motivate you to see the least and help them?

4. Read Luke 4:16-21. Do you think the points of Jesus’ mission are only to be interpreted in a spiritual sense or also in a literal sense? Why?

5. How does the mission of Jesus and the priorities for His church expand your understand of the gospel? How do these priorities relate to Ken Morris’ message this weekend?

6. As God’s people seek to carry out Jesus’ mission, which area of concern do you tend to give priority to and which do you tend to neglect?

7. Who are the “least of these” in your life? What might Jesus be calling you to do in response to these passages?
